# **BCPE Staff Changes**



This past year has seen a lot of staffing changes at BCPE. The most significant was the retirement of our Executive Director, Carol Stuart-Buttle, MS, CPE. Carol earned her CPE credential in 1993, then served on the board as a director from 1996-2004. In 2012 Carol was hired to serve as the BCPE Executive Director, a role that she performed admirably. Carol's superpower in this role was connecting BCPE with affiliated organizations, knowing who-we-should-know, and knowing important historical references that assisted several boards to in making sound decisions.

When Carol announced her retirement the Board conducted a broad search for a new Executive Director. However, after many interviews and making several offers, we couldn't find a candidate that met our needs and budget. We then reevaluated the options and looked internally.

An internal review led us to promote Kris Rightmire to a new position – Director of Operations. Kris is BCPE's longest-serving staffer, having begun her career with BCPE in December 1993. Initially, Kris was an Administrative Assistant, hired to process the large influx of applications submitted at the onset of BCPE certification. In 1999 Kris was promoted to Executive

Administrator, taking on more significant roles including financial, database and web site management. Now as Director of Operations, Kris has assumed additional responsibilities, including board, communications, and exam supervision.

Kris is supported in her role with a new Executive Assistant, Heather Walston. Heather's responsibilities will include application processing, helping candidates register for the exam and continuance of certification oversight, and other tasks as necessary. Welcome, Heather!



# **Annual Meeting Highlights**

The BCPE Board of Directors held their 2022 Annual Meeting in Atlanta, GA on October 14 and 15 at the end of the Human Factors & Ergonomics Society Annual Meeting. The agenda for this meeting emphasized committee work and strategic planning. The following summarizes the meeting reports and activities.

- Application submissions have reached and exceeded pre-pandemic levels. Year to date (9/30/22) applications total 76: 16 Professional, 34 Associate and 9 transition applications. The number of Professional applications is expected to increase with the application deadline at the end of November (for the spring 2023 exam).
- The Exam Committee continues to validate new exam questions (carried over from the spring exam). Also researched and selected a new psychometrician to replace our current one who retired after the spring exam.
- The Outreach Committee gave an update on the Ambassador program. Shared email templates drafted for reaching out to new societies/organizations about BCPE and ergonomics certification.
- Communications and Media reported the official BCPE and Discussion LinkedIn pages are now clearly differentiated. Posting guidelines have been added to the Discussion page.

# **Educational Coursework Change**

The educational coursework waiver has been extended to anyone who has graduated from a program listed in the HFES Graduate Directory. This was previously only offered to graduates of an HFES accredited program. The change was approved by the Board at the recommendation of the Exam Committee at the Annual Meeting and implemented following the meeting.

#### **DENNY YU**

Dr. Yu is currently an Assistant Professor of Industrial Engineering at Purdue University and a Certified Professional Ergonomist (CPE). He is also an Adjunct Assistant Professor of Surgery at Indiana University School of Medicine and a Summer Faculty Fellow at the Air Force 711<sup>th</sup> Human Performance Wing. Dr. Yu's expertise is in human factors engineering, with a focus on discovering objective features from sensors and health datasets for understanding human behavior and performance in complex,

high-stress environments. In conducting this work, he has received funding from agencies such as NIH, AFOSR, NSF, Indiana Clinical and Translational Sciences Institute (CTSI), NIOSH, and multiple industry sponsors.

## **ROSE FIGUEROA**

Dr. Rose Figueroa is a Certified Human Factors Professional and Managing Scientist at Explico, an engineering consulting firm, where she investigates accidents throughout the US, Mexico, and the Caribbean. She has experience in a broad range of settings such as industrial and occupational, commercial / passenger / recreational vehicles, medical inpatient/outpatient / surgical, boating/watersports, and customer, residential, and public grounds.



Trailblazing the path for the past decade, she has served as a diversity, equity, and inclusion (DEI) strategic consultant, speaker, and workshop facilitator for Fortune 500 companies, non-profits, universities, and startups. As a result, she is the Founder and Program Director at belongIN.org. Dr. Figueroa has also led impactful philanthropic initiatives, including state-wide relief efforts, she serves in multiple national organizations (i.e., SHPE, HFES), and is the Chair Advisory Board Chair for Women of Color in the Workplace.



#### **PENNEY STANCH**



# **FPE Student Award Submission Deadline**

The Foundation for Professional Ergonomics has announced the 2023 deadline for the Dieter W. Jahns Student Practitioner Award. The award was created in memory of Dieter Jahns, a lifelong advocate of the practice of ergonomics and a leader in ergonomics certification. The submission deadline for the 2023 award is June 30. Notification of the winner will be sent by July 31, 2023.

The annual award is given to the student (or group of students) for a project that demonstrates the major practice areas of ergonomics: Analysis, Design, and Integration. The purpose of the award is to advance professionalism in ergonomics by recognizing educational activities that demonstrate how professional ergonomists serve to make people's lives at work and at home healthier, safer, more productive, and more satisfying. The award is open to all students in ergonomics and ergonomics-related programs. Students who have completed their graduate degrees within one year of submitting are also eligible. The award and cash prize of \$1,000 will be presented at the BCPE Reception, during the HFES Annual Meeting, October 24, 2023.
